Instructions for Leaders

Having an internet scavenger hunt is a great way to introduce your Guides to the World Centres' websites and the opportunities available for members of WAGGGS to visit and work at a World Centre.

You could give the scavenger hunt sheets to the girls as a "take-home" challenge for a badge.

Alternatively, see if you can hire a computer suite for a unit meeting. Some libraries, schools and community centres may have computer suites that you can use free of charge! Depending on the girls' ages and the number of computers and girls, the girls can then work on the challenge alone or in pairs or threes.

If you want to make it into a competition, you can award points for each correct answer.

You could also offer a bonus challenge, being to write a message on the notice board/chat room of one of the World Centres. Of course, you should make sure the girls show the message to you first so you can make sure it is appropriate! Please note that ideally the girls should not use chat rooms as a way to find pen friends. Many associations have a procedure for obtaining pen friends from overseas, so you may wish to check what your association's policy is about this.
